Wildlife presentation by Sri. M.N. Jayakumar, IFS, Addl. PCCF(Retd.), MFIAP, FRPS.

All Digital Salon

As you may be aware, this is the first Digital Salon being held in the history of YPS. This is an "All Digital" Salon where entries are accepted only over internet. A completely new web-site for the Salon was created with facility to register and upload the images under each category. The pictures are checked for size to conform to Salon rules before they are accepted on the website. Payment for Salon participation was done through online Bank transfers to the Salon account. A 'Contact us' page helped participants to raise any queries or seek help. Option for email was also available on the salon website. Further the 'Terms and Conditions' 'Status' and 'Awards' were available online.

All Digital Judging

To complement the "All Digital" Salon participation, YPS also created a state-of-the-art online judging system and used the same for the judging process.

The website for the salon entry was created by our member Sri. Deepak Eshwar, and the software for judging was created by both Sri. Murali Santhanam and Deepak Eshwar. YPS committee and all members thank these two master minds for their exemplary work. Due to their efforts, YPS had its own salon website and software for judging.

October 17: Portrait workshop

As many as 19 participants (excluding executive committee) attended and benefitted from the Portrait Workshop conducted by Sri. B.K. Agrawal from Vishakapatnam. We had two models and one make up man also. Mr. Agrawal, elaborately described the various angle of lighting, quality and placement of lightings. He showed how to place lights for different kind of persons. Along with explanation, he also demonstrated the use of Honeycomb, Fill in light, Reflectors, different source of lights etc. Two sets of lighting were hired, one from Sri. Shylesh, YPS member and another from a third party. Two models were placed in different set ups, so that people can utilize the opportunity and timing. Since more number of participants were there, it was bit difficult to pay individual attention. We thank Sri. B.K. Agrawal for coming over here and teaching us the art of portraiture.
